SECTION 1 - TOURNAMENT I:

DATE:

Saturday, October 17, 2009 at 11:00 a.m. for singles, 1:00 p.m. for doubles.

PARTICIPANTS:

Any pitcher will be eligible to compete.

ENTRYFEE:

Each participant will be charged \$5.00 to enter the singles competition and \$5.00 to enter the doubles competition. These fees will be collected the day of the tournament.

FORMAT:

A pitcher will be placed in a singles class based on their ability. In the doubles competition upper class pitchers will draw from the lower class pitchers to determine their partner. A round robin format will be used.

HORSESHOES:

You should bring your own horseshoes if possible.
