**INFORMATION FOR DAIRY GOAT EXHIBITORS**

**CHECK IN:** Absolutely no pens will be available before 10:00 a.m. Friday, October 23, 2009. No tack pens will be provided. **Animals will not be allowed to enter the barns until inspected and passed by health officials. An approval card will be issued after inspection, prior to entering the barn.** ANIMALS MUST BE IN PLACE: Friday, October 23, **at 5:00 p.m.**, NO EXCEPTIONS. Animals must be checked in with Show Secretary by **7:00 p.m.**

**SHOW DATE:** The Open Junior Doe Show starts immediately following the Youth Show on Saturday, October 24. All Open Senior Does will be judged Sunday, October 25 starting at 8:00 a.m. Youth Showmanship-Friday, October 23 at 8:00 p.m., Youth Dairy Goat Show-Saturday, October 24 at 8:00 a.m.

**RELEASE TIME:** All exhibitors both out-of-state and in-state not requested to stay will be released at the conclusion of the Open Senior Doe Show. Anyone leaving prior to release forfeits all premiums. Any exhibitor (and animals) unable to leave upon release must make arrangements with the NC State Fair and Dairy Goat Superintendent to stay overnight. Overnight stay will have to be in some area other than the Kelley Building. The NC State Fair and the Dairy Goat Superintendent are **not** responsible for any personal losses **including animals.**

**COMPETITION:** Open to animals registered or recorded in the American Dairy Goat Association, American Goat Society, or the Canadian Society. The Senior Doe Show and the Junior Doe Show each have separate ADGA sanction.

**ENTRIES:** Must be postmarked no later than September 15, 2009. Entry fee is \$5.00 per animal. There are no pen fees. The right is reserved to reject entries after all available space has been taken. No late entries will be accepted.

**PRE-SHOW COVERED DISH DINNER:** Starting at 6:00 p.m. Friday, October 23, 2009 ending at 8:00 p.m. prior to youth showmanship. Bring your favorite dish and share in the fellowship.

**HEALTH REGULATIONS FOR GOATS**

**Be sure to read these under "Rules and Regulations of the Livestock Division" before entering.** Any questionable health problems will be referred to the livestock director and/or the State Veterinarian. Animals with obvious abscesses (opened or unopened), ringworm, soremouth or any other contagious disease **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE BARN.** All goats must be appropriately identified and

comply with USDA and NCDA&CS Scrapie Eradication Program guidelines. Call 1-866-USDA TAG (873-2824) or 919 855-7707 for more information.

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entries must comply with both ADGA and NC State Fair rules. Be thoroughly familiar with both. It is your responsibility as an exhibitor to read and be familiar with all rules!
2. Be sure to use the official entry form and include the animal's tattoo. List the class number in which the animal will be shown. Also, indicate any group classes to be entered. Any animals competing in a group class must have competed in her individual class.
3. Substitutions of animals will be allowed only within a breed and class. This rule will be strictly enforced.
4. A registration paper or a stamped duplicate (for animals under 6 months of age) is required for each animal. Proof of ownership shall be the name on the registration paper or recordation certificate. No signed transfers will be accepted.
5. No exhibitor shall receive more than 2 premiums per class. Except, group classes in which exhibitor is limited to 1 premium. This is in accordance to NC State Fair rules.
6. Entry in the Champion Challenge class is open to permanent champions only. Qualifications must be by registration/recordation or certificate by the American Dairy Goat Association. Champion Challenge competitors shall **not** be foreclosed from group or progeny classes. Shift from regular classes to Champion Challenge may be made, with proof of qualification, any time before the beginning of judging of the breed.
7. When filling in the entry form the Dept. Letter is O, Subdept. is A - the class number depends on the breed and the age of the animal. For example, a 6 year old Saanen would use class number 160 under class number on the entry form. Please fill out all spaces for each animal to be entered on the entry form.
8. **A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM MUST BE USED FOR THE YOUTH SHOW (OB), JUNIOR DOE SHOW (OA), AND THE SENIOR DOE SHOW (OA).** Check appropriate boxes on the entry form. Write Youth on entry for Youth Show. There are forms in the back of this catalog. An exhibitor who wants to show in all three shows, **must fill out entry forms for each show**-Open Junior Doe Show, Open Senior Doe Show and Youth Show.
9. If entering more than one breed, please group all animals by breed.
10. BE SURE TO INCLUDE YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER ON YOUR ENTRY TO RECEIVE PREMIUM MONIES.
11. The breeds to be shown and the show order will be as follows: Saanen, Toggenburg, Alpine, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, and Recorded Grades.
12. Due to NC State Fair Fire Code no heavy electrical appliances will be allowed on the fairgrounds.
13. No pre-entry in the udder class. 1st and 2nd place udder in each class, as selected by the judge compete for best udder of breed. No premiums will be awarded for udder class.

**SHOW DATE:** Showmanship-FRIDAY, OCTOBER 23, 2009 AT 8:00 P.M.

Youth Dairy Goat Show-SATURDAY, OCTOBER 24, 2009 AT 8:00 A.M.

**RELEASE TIME:** All exhibitors and animals not requested to stay will be released at the conclusion of the Open Senior Doe Show. Anyone leaving prior to release forfeits all premiums. Any exhibitor (and animals) unable to leave upon release must make arrangements with the NC State Fair and Dairy Goat Superintendent to stay overnight. Overnight stay will have to be in some area other than the Kelley Building. The NC State Fair and the Dairy Goat Superintendent are not responsible for any personal losses including animals.

3. List the class number in which the animal will be shown and included any group classes an animal is to enter. In order to be shown in a group class, the animal must have competed in her individual class.  
**Youth Show Udder Class must be pre-entered.**
4. Open to all exhibitors under age 21, prior to the day of the show and residents of North Carolina.
5. The exhibitor must be the bona fide owner of the exhibit on the show day. Proof of ownership shall be the name on the registration or recordation certificate. No

signed transfers will be accepted. No family or farm ownerships will be considered for the Youth Show.

- 6. **Each class is limited to 2 animals per exhibitor. The exhibitor must show one of these animals. The exhibitor may designate another Junior Handlers, with the approval of the Show Superintendent and Show Secretary.**
- 7. Substitutions of animals will be allowed only on a within breed and class basis.
- 8. A registration paper or a stamped duplicate (for animals under the age of six months) is required for each animal.
- 9. The health regulations of the Veterinary Division of the NCDA will be strictly enforced. **Be sure to read these under "Rules and Regulations of the Livestock Division" before entering.** Any questionable health problems will be referred to the livestock director and/or the State Veterinarian.
