CHECK IN: Open show animals will be checked in on Tuesday, October 20, 2009, 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Animals will not be allowed to enter the barns until inspected and passed by health officials. An approval card will be issued after inspection, prior to entering the barn.

SHOW DATE: Wednesday, October 21, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. - Order of show: Percentage does, Fullblood/Purebred does, Fullblood/Purebred bucks

RELEASE TIME: Open Show animals will be released at 7:00 pm Wednesday, October 21, 2009, or in the event that the show continues past 7:00 pm, at the conclusion of the show. Animals leaving prior to release time will not receive any premiums. Animals must be removed from the barn before 6:00 am on Thursday, October 22, 2009.

PARTICIPANTS: Open to the World

ENTRIES: Entries will be limited to 2 animals per class for each exhibitor. Exhibitors must have legal ownership of the entry for at least 60 days prior to the show or since birth. An entry fee of \$5.00 per head is required, fee due with entry form. This is an official ABGA sanctioned show and the following ABGA rules will be followed:

SHOW RULES

1. Eligibility: Only animals registered in a recognized Association may be shown.
2. The base date for computing ages for entries shall be the date the animals are to be judged.
3. A registration certificate is required for all animals.
4. No copies of registration or stamped duplicate of official registration will be accepted by the show officials unless the animal is under six (6) months of age.
5. The documents specified above as the requirements for that age animal to be shown must be presented to the superintendent for verification before the judging begins (check-in time).
6. Proof of ownership shall be the name on the registration document.
7. An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge from whom it was purchased or possession taken within 90 days of show.
8. An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge who is his/her immediate family or employer or employee.
9. An exhibitor that is showing an animal with a microchip as permanent identification is required to provide a microchip reader for verification of animal identity.
10. If an animal is registered, that registration number must be listed on the entry form.
11. An exhibitor shall not knowingly show an animal that does not meet eligibility requirements.

12. It is the responsibility of the show secretary to have a copy of these rules available at all times in case any questions arise during the course of the show.

HEALTH: The health regulations of the Veterinary Division of the NCDA will be strictly enforced. **Be sure to read these under "Rules and Regulations of the Livestock Division" before entering.** Any questionable health problems will be referred to the livestock director and/or the State Veterinarian. Animals with obvious abscesses (opened or unopened), ringworm, soremouth or any other contagious disease **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE BARN. CHECK IN AND WEIGHING: WETHERS and COMMERCIAL DOES will be weighed, tagged, and checked in between 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon on Monday, October 19, 2009 in the Kelley Building. Animals will not be allowed to enter the barns until inspected and passed by health officials. An approval card will be issued after inspection, prior to entering the barn. *NOTE: The Kelley Building will be in the process of being cleaned on Sunday night and Monday morning. Goats will not be allowed in the building until after cleaning is completed.*

SHOW DATE: WETHERS - Monday, October 19 at 3:00 p.m.

COMMERCIAL DOES - Tuesday, October 20 at 9:00 a.m. The Jr. Breeder Doe Show will be at 2:00 p.m.

RELEASE TIME: Junior commercial does will be released immediately after the show. Wethers will be loaded out after the sale. Junior Breeder does not qualifying for the open show will be released after the Junior Breeder Show. Junior meat goats leaving prior to release time will not receive any premium.

JUNIOR MEAT GOAT SALE: Monday, October 19, 2009 at 8:00 p.m. Champion and Reserve Champion will be on display in the State Fair Ark after the sale.

EXHIBITORS: WETHERS: All exhibitors must be residents of North Carolina 18 years of age or younger as of January 1, 2009, and be able to show the animal on their own.

COMM. DOES: All exhibitors must be residents of North Carolina 21 years of age or younger as of January 1, 2009, and be able to show the animal on their own.

JUNIOR MARKET GOATS: Only wethers-**NO DOES**-with all baby teeth and weighing 50 to 120 lbs. will be allowed to show. **All horn tips must be dulled and/or blunt.**

NOTE-all market wethers will be sold. This is a terminal show. All exhibitors will have one wether in the sale; the second wether will be sold in the truck load group.

JUNIOR COMMERCIAL DOES: Commercial doe kid class for does with all baby teeth in place. Commercial senior doe division class for does that have at least one baby tooth missing and have no more than 4 permanent teeth. All commercial does will be ear tagged at check in. **Goats showing in the commercial doe classes will not be allowed to show in the open show on Wednesday.**

ENTRY DEADLINE: September 15, 2009

ENTRIES: Each exhibitor may exhibit a total of two junior market goats and a total of four junior commercial does (2 kid does and 2 senior does), maximum total of six (6)

animals in the Junior Meat Goat Show. Junior meat goats must have been owned and cared for by the exhibitor since September 1, 2009.

CLASSES: Market classes will be determined by ascending weights with a maximum of 15 animals per class. Junior commercial doe classes will be determined by age according to teeth. Kids with all baby teeth will be classed separate from does with at least one baby tooth missing and no more than 4 permanent teeth. There will be a maximum of 15 does per class.

HEALTH: The health regulations of the Veterinary Division of the NCDA will be strictly enforced. **Be sure to read these under "Rules and Regulations of the Livestock Division" before entering.** Any questionable health problems will be referred to the livestock director and/or the State Veterinarian. Animals with obvious abscesses (opened or unopened), ringworm, soremouth or any other contagious disease **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE BARN. SHOW DATE: Tuesday, October 20, 2009 at 2:00 p.m.

RELEASE TIME: Junior breeder does will be released to go home at the conclusion of the show.

SHOW RULES

GENERAL: ABGA Sanction Show Rules shall govern

EXHIBITORS: All exhibitors shall be residents of North Carolina, 18 years of age or younger as of January 1, 2009, and be able to show the animal on their own.

ENTRIES: Entries shall be limited to two (2) does per class. There is not an entry fee. There will not be a sale. **OPEN SHOW NOTE:** All 1st and 2nd place does in each class will be eligible to be entered in the Open Show on Wednesday. No Entry Fee Required. The remaining does will not be allowed in the open show.

ELIGIBILITY OF ANIMALS: All goats must be registered in the herdbook of a recognized association prior to September 15, 2009 *in the name of the exhibitor*. Original registration certificates are required - papers and tattoos will be checked at check in.

TATTOOS: All goats must have legible tattoos or other means of permanent identification consistent with its registration certificate or the animal will be disqualified.

COMPUTING AGES: Birth dates, as listed on the registration certificate will be used to determine the class divisions.

CLASSES: All animals must be registered purebred, fullblood or percentage blood Boer goats.

DISQUALIFICATION: Any goat showing any pronounced defect or abnormality will be barred from the show. Artificial coloring will be a disqualification as well as illegible tattoos or tattoos that are inconsistent with the goat's registration papers.

ENTRY DEADLINE: September 15, 2009. This will be strictly enforced.

HEALTH: The health regulations of the Veterinary Division of the NCDA will be strictly enforced. **Be sure to read these under "Rules and Regulations of the Livestock Division" before entering.** Any questionable health problems will be referred to the livestock director and/or the State Veterinarian.
