It is only natural that the State Fair should recognize the talent and desire of these entrants in the field of agriculture. The North Carolina State Fair and Livestock Department are grateful for the support and efforts provided by the people involved to enable this competition to grow and expand.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. DO NOT ENTER ONLINE - fill out a completed entry form to include the exhibitor name, social security number, mailing address and telephone number. There will not be a processing fee, fair passes will be mailed to you. **Exhibitors may only enter one of the special awards shows.** Enter in either the Livestock Special Awards Show on Saturday, October 14 showing a heifer, and a lamb or goat OR the Dairy Special Awards Show on Sunday, October 22 showing a dairy goat and a dairy calf.
2. Each exhibitor must be identified as intellectually challenged, developmentally disabled or special needs. Parent, guardian, teacher, supervisor or physician verification of disability MUST ACCOMPANY entry form. Disability may be questioned before premiums are paid.
3. Exhibitors must be residents of North Carolina. **Exhibitors will be limited to the first 45 entries received by September 15th.**
4. Health regulations of the Veterinary Division of the N.C. Department of Agriculture will be strictly enforced. **BE SURE TO READ THESE UNDER "GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE LIVESTOCK DIVISION"** before entering or competing in this department. Animals and a helper will be provided for the exhibitor.
5. Some rules from other shows will apply.
6. Premium money in the amount of \$50 per exhibit will be awarded along with a medal.
