

Bella's Birthday Bash Challenge

MINI DOG BIRTHDAY CAKE

All ingredients are dog friendly

- 1 cup all purpose flour
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- 1/4 cup coconut oil - melted
- 1 egg
- 1/3 cup honey - raw
- 1/4 cup canned pumpkin
- 1/4 cup applesauce
- 1/4 cup raw organic peanut butter
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract

To prepare:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
2. Grease 3 - 6 inch cake pans (2 round pans and 1 dome shaped pan) - set aside
3. In a large bowl, combine flour and baking soda - set aside
4. Melt coconut oil in a saucepan over low - medium heat.
5. While coconut is melting, whisk egg, egg, honey, pumpkin, applesauce peanut butter and vanilla together in a large bowl using an electric mixer. Last stir in the melted coconut oil .
6. Fold the wet ingredients into the dry and stir to combine.
7. Pour batter evenly into the 3 pans. Place the cake pans on a baking sheet in the oven.
8. Bake cakes for 20-30 minutes or until a toothpick comes out mostly clean,
9. Let the cakes sit in the pans for 10 minutes before running a knife along the edges.

Icing:

- 1 1/2 cup peanut butter (organic ground - Whole Foods)

Decorations:

Red tomatoes dog biscuit recipe:

- 2 cups all purpose flour
- 6 Tbsp oil
- 2/3 cups water - add only enough to make a dough.

Options:

- 1/2 cup rolled oats
- 1 cooked beet - for red tomato color

Beggin' Dog Treats

Cheese

Stir all together until forming a dough. Roll out on a cookie sheet and using a cookie cutter make round tomato shaped dog biscuits. Bake for 10 -20 minutes. Turn off oven and leave tomatoes in oven until crispy.

Bottom cake - frost with peanut butter icing. Place on place. Add lettuce on top of bottom cake.

Middle cake - make icing with melted Carob chips mixed with the icing and ice layer completely. Using the large crushed Bark Bars roll around outside edge of middle layer to look like a hamburger. Place on top of bottom layer Add tomato shaped dog biscuits, cheese and Begin Strips, on top of hamburger shaped layer. Frost the dome shaped cake with peanut butter icing.

For eyes: make small batch of mashed potatoes. Using the melted Carob chips and let solidify make round eyeballs and attach to mashed potatoes. Add peanuts to top to resemble sesame seeds. Place a stick in middle of cake to keep from falling.
